# *A Message from the Board of Trustees*

Two roads diverged in a wood,  
And I took the one less traveled by,  
And that has made all the difference.

Robert Frost's poem, *The Road Not Taken*, reflects the reality that choices are an unavoidable aspect of travelling the road of life, some more difficult than others and some more important than others. We know that the many complexities of life as well as the burdens of our decisions affect the future. At Notre Dame we came to a fork in the road and made the choice to develop a strategic plan that will position the school to thrive in the 21st century. The Board of Trustees revised the school's mission and worked on three initiatives that would assure the school's path to success. The areas include Academic Excellence, Increased Enrollment and Revenue Enhancement.

Our goals within the academic portion of the plan will position the school to provide a 21st century learning and teaching environment. It will ensure that our curriculum, faculty and instructional strategies provide our students with the necessary skills, experiences and knowledge to be successful at the college of their choice.

Our goals within enrollment portion of the plan is directly linked to our commitment to increase our student population by a minimum of five students per year, over the next three years, while retaining the prior year's enrolled students. Reaching and maintaining this goal has required the action team to review, redesign and implement a written recruitment process, all in an effort to build a strong body of potential,

student prospects – prospects that can realistically be converted into enrolled students at a higher success rate than in the past.

Our goals within the revenue enhancement portion of the plan seek to create fiscal stability and provide the fiscal resources necessary to grow enrollment and achieve academic excellence. The responsible action team has developed a Board financial reporting process, which incorporates financial forecasts for operations and cash flow. The group is working on a three-year financial plan, which will allow the needs identified within the academic and enrollment sections of this comprehensive plan to be met with the fiscal resources needed for success in all areas.

Notre Dame has served the community well and planning for the future is an essential step in ensuring that the educational ministry of the Sisters of Mercy, in the Southern Tier of New York and the Northern Tier of Pennsylvania, is ongoing. We are hopeful and proud as we work to provide a quality Catholic education backed by financial stability. We have made the hard choices, and while the road may have been less traveled and not nearly as smooth as we may have wished, we join Frost in believing that the choice to take it has “made all the difference.” Our greatest successes are surely before us.

Thank you for your support of our efforts and we ask you to pray for the growth and success of the school as we move into the 21st century.

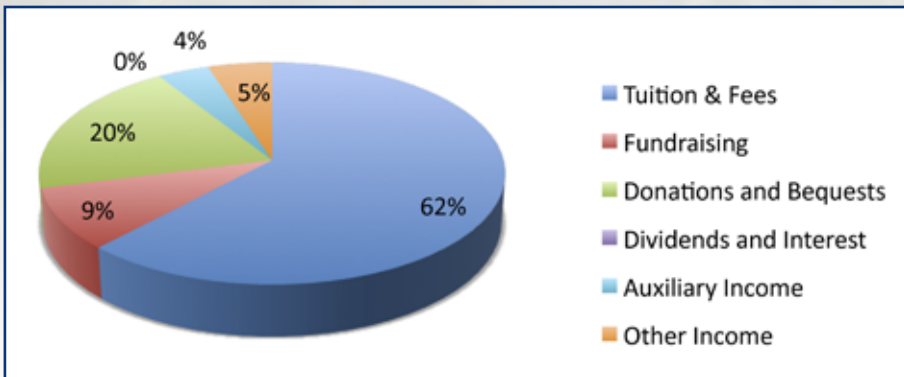

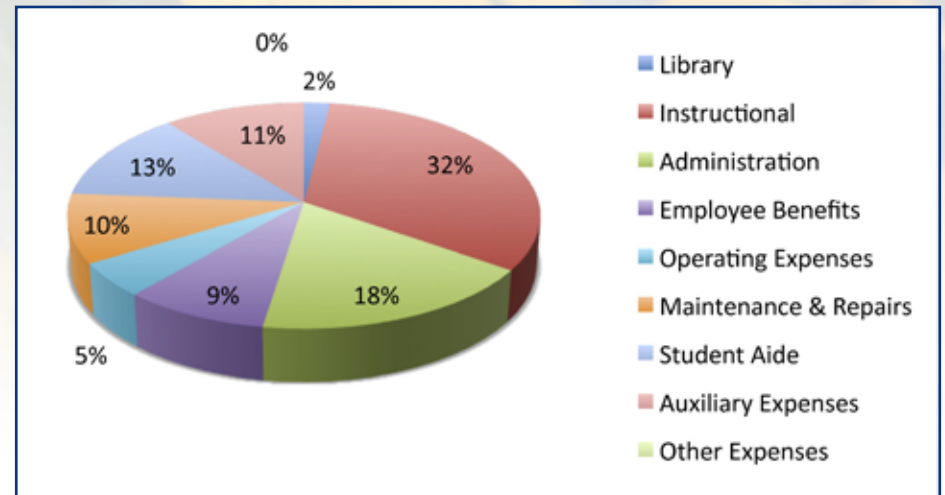

### \*\* Tax Cut Extension Bill

Last December, Congress passed a bill commonly referred to as the "Tax Cut Extension Bill" which the President signed into law. One provision of this legislation extends the popular IRA Charitable

Rollover for all of 2011. Donors who have not yet taken their mandatory distribution now have until December 31, 2011 to make a tax-free, roll-over contribution to a qualified charity. The same conditions apply as in years past:

- The donor must be age 70 ½ or older;
- The tax-free transfer limit is \$100,000 per individual; and
- The distribution must be made directly from an IRA or Roth IRA to a qualified charity like Notre Dame High School.

The direct transfers from an IRA to Notre Dame High School will not increase your adjusted gross income for 2011 federal income tax purposes, and they can be counted toward your required minimum distribution (RMD) if you meet the criteria above.

Please contact your IRA custodian or a qualified financial advisor as soon as possible if you meet the qualifications and would like to take advantage of the tax benefits while supporting Notre Dame High School's annual fund, or endowment

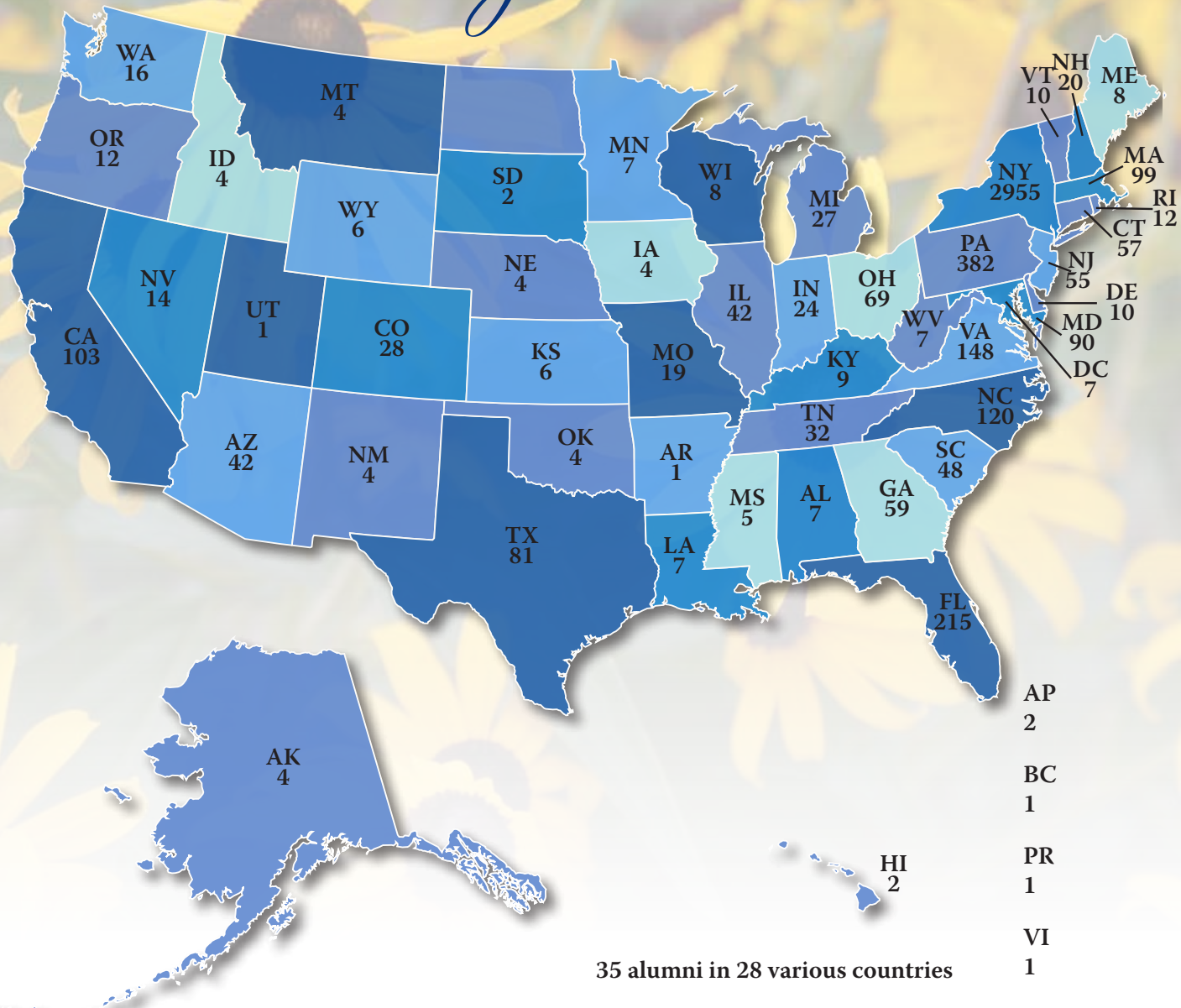
