



TRANSPORTATION TO NOTRE DAME

Notre Dame High School's student body is comprised of students bused to Notre Dame from a wide variety of school districts. To determine if your student is eligible for transportation, please contact your local school district bus garage. For students that are eligible for transportation, many of the area school districts require written documentation of your request for transportation of your student(s) to Notre Dame by **April 1**; however, *please be aware the deadline may vary across districts.*

It is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to be aware of their district transportation request guidelines. Parents must submit any necessary transportation request *each school year*. Please reach out to the Transportation Department of your school district to learn your district requirements and deadlines and complete the necessary paper work for your student's transportation for next year.
