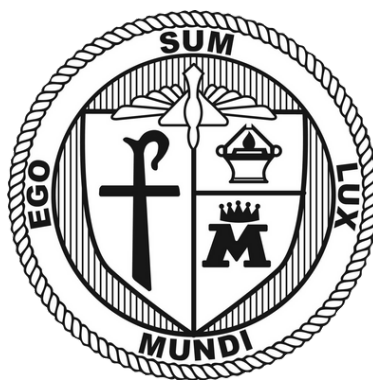

## *From the PRESIDENT EMERITA*



Dear Friends of Notre Dame,

In 1952, the then Bishop of the Diocese of Rochester, James E. Kearney announced the purchase of 25 and ½ acres on lower Maple Avenue, in Elmira as the site for a large Catholic High school. He reported that the Sisters of Mercy would sponsor the school. Catholics from Elmira and the surrounding areas, under the leadership of Cornelius Milliken raised over \$600,000, which was \$100,000 over the established goal for the project. The Rochester Sisters of Mercy financed the remainder of the 1.5 million dollar cost.

Since the 1950's the Sisters of Mercy have sponsored Notre Dame High School and have depended on the generosity, support and leadership of others in the community to contribute to the growth and excellence of the school through their time, talent and treasure.

During the 2021-2022 school year, Notre Dame was supported by 438 donors and \$\$429,227.99 of income to the Annual Fund. This treasure contributed to excellence in the classroom, successful competition on the athletic field and many hours of service to the surrounding local community. It provided financial assistance to students enabling the continued creation of a cosmopolitan school community.

A hundred thousand thank-yous for your generosity of the past year. Your belief in the dream of Bishop Kearney and the words of Catherine McAuley about education, "No works of charity can be more productive than the education of young women" and men gives us hope in our future. We appreciate your generosity and continued support.

## *Sponsor a Student*

### **Tuition**

Your financial support can provide a student in need with a Notre Dame education; options include full or partial tuition payments.

### **Sports Fees**

Notre Dame athletes are required to pay a \$150 fee per sport to cover costs associated with uniforms, equipment, etc.

### **Graduation Fees**

Notre Dame High School seniors are each required to pay a fee of \$125 to cover various expenses relating to graduation (cap & gown, program & ticket printing, etc.).

### **Lunch Expenses**

The Notre Dame cafeteria provides nutritious breakfast & lunch options to all students on a daily basis. Your support can provide a student with breakfast and/or lunch for a week, month, semester, etc.

### **Exam Fees**

Notre Dame is pleased to offer students the opportunity to attend various AP classes in order to earn college-level credits with attending NDHS. Each of these classes requires a final exam at a cost to the student. Additionally, students taking the ACT exam and/or the SAT exam are required to pay a fee in order to take the exam.

### **Mercy Online Education Fees**

Mercy Online is a supplemental education offering that provides Notre Dame students with the option of attending classes online in addition to the curriculum offered in-person at Notre Dame. The cost to students for these classes is per credit.

Notre Dame's family-oriented community has made the 2021-2022 school year one of adventure, celebration and success!

In February, work began to update and refurbish the former convent on campus for its new incarnation as an International Dormitory. The entire school community joined together to work on the project, offering supplies and hard work to create an inviting space for our new Crusaders to feel at home while attending ND. We cleaned, made trips to Goodwill and the county dump, painted, pulled up rugs, dressed windows, and decorated the space with enthusiasm and excitement. Teachers, faculty, parents, students, and other volunteers began this process together and continued their work throughout the summer! In the spring, I traveled

to Panama, Peru, Columbia, Argentina, Chile, and Brazil to meet with prospective students and their families. This experience was eye opening as I began to make connections with agencies and families by showcasing Notre Dame in person. These pillars of Notre Dame, Robert Agan '56, Daniel Burke, John Gough, and John Potter, Sr., have given selflessly to ND for over 40 years. As Simone de Beauvoir once stated, "You give your all, and yet you always feel as if it costs you nothing." These men exemplify Christian values in all that they do and have done for others. In celebration of our Pillars of Notre Dame, the basketball court was named the "John T. Gough Court", and the three wings of our newly remodeled International Dorm were named after Bob Agan, Dan Burke, and John Potter Sr. Two separate celebrations were planned "Honoring the Pillars of Notre Dame" and, once again, our community stepped in raising funds in their names to complete a \$400,000 Capital Campaign to replace the entire school roof.

Notre Dame High School continues to strive for excellence. What sets us apart from the public school systems are the close knit relationships and Mercy mission we live every day. We are grateful for all of our families who share in this mission with us and we look forward to the future.

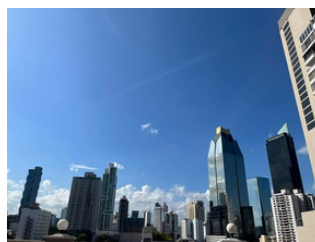

## Notre Dame High School Profile

**Notre Dame High School** is a co-educational Catholic secondary school sponsored by the Sisters of Mercy of the Americas. Our 247 students come from ten different school districts in the Southern Tier of New York and the Northern Tier of Pennsylvania. Notre Dame High School is accredited by the Middle States Association of Colleges and Secondary Schools and by the University of the State of New York.

Our **Administration and Faculty** consists of a President Emerita, Head of School, Assistant Head of School, two full-time guidance counselors, one academic advisor, twenty-nine full and part-time teachers, and a Campus Minister.

**Curriculum** programs are primarily college preparatory. The core curriculum is composed of required courses in English, Foreign Language (Spanish and Mandarin Chinese), Mathematics, Science, History, Theology, and Physical Education. Elective courses are available in Art, Business, Music, Science, History, and the Social Sciences. The school operates on a five-day cycle with nine periods each day. Classes are 40 minutes long, with double periods for science labs. All students are required to take six and a half credits each year, with many opting to take seven or seven and a half credits.

Notre Dame High School offers **AP and ACE courses** in English, Biology, Calculus, Chemistry, American Federal Government, Physics, Service Learning, Art, Spanish, and Statistics. Students can earn the following **diplomas**: Regents, Regents with Advanced Designation, Regents with Advanced Designation and Honors, and Local (students with a 504 plan or IEP are eligible for this option). Students may also earn the distinction of Honors, Mastery in Math, and Mastery in Science.

Average SAT and ACT scores for graduating classes at Notre Dame High School are consistently above the national averages. The average scores for the Class of 2022 are outlined below:

**Service** to others is an integral component of our Theology courses as well as our commitment to the beliefs of the Sisters of Mercy of the Americas. It is our goal to have our graduates make service a permanent part of their lives as citizens of the world.

Our **Co-Curricular Activities** help to create a sense of balance in the students' days. Notre Dame High School competes in twenty varsity and six junior varsity sports, in addition to several modified teams. Letters are awarded in all varsity sports including baseball, basketball, bowling, cross country, football, golf, lacrosse, soccer, softball, swimming, tennis, and track & field. Students are also encouraged to participate in the many clubs, organizations, and service opportunities that are available to them. These options include the *Maryleaf* (school newspaper), *Credo* (yearbook), Robotics, and Science Olympiad. Opportunities in the Arts include Theater (a drama and a musical), Concert Choir, Select Choir, Symphonic Band, and Jazz Ensemble.

## *The McAuley Award*

The The 16th Annual McAuley Award dinner was held on Tuesday, October 19, 2021 at the Elmira Country Club. The Award, named for Catherine McAuley, who founded the Sisters of Mercy in 1831 in Dublin, Ireland, pays tribute to those who have worked diligently to improve the lives of others through dedicated service. Their service mirrors Catherine's life work of caring for others.

Clare and Jan van den Blink are leaders in the Elmira community and service to others is their mantra. Besides running a century old family business which employs more than 500 workers and ships products around the globe, they both have helped to support many causes and not-for-profit organizations. Jan's leadership and involvement include STEG, the Chamber of Commerce, and the Community Foundation. Clare has been a source of strength for Catholic Charities, Elmira College, the Fund for Women, and the Arnot Art Museum. They are aspirational and inspirational models of committed community building volunteers.

Service defines the life of Michael Johnston, Sr. '64. His tenure as Interim Head of School in July 2020 compliments his many years of dedication and service as student, athlete, parent, teacher, Coach, Athletic Director, and Assistant Principal at Notre Dame High School. In July of 2020, Mike was an essential worker as the school prepared for the COVID opening in the fall. He helped with rearranging the school for appropriate social distancing, opening the International Dorm for seventh grade classrooms, and managing all the complicated issues for athletics. In the spring of 2021, he helped train the school's new Athletic Manager, personally invited every boy who was not already on a team to join, and then coached varsity football, eventually becoming the interim Athletic Manager

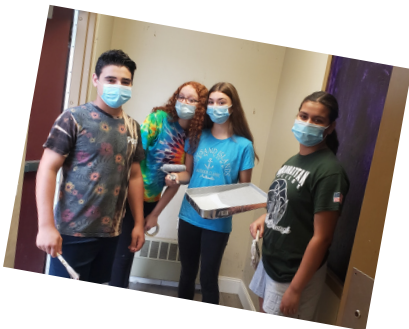
# Mercy Week

In September of 2021, our Notre Dame student body tackled a Mercy Week service project that had been postponed for a year due to Covid shutdowns. Both the Southside Community Center and Notre Dame High School closed 2 weeks prior to the scheduled renovations at the Community Center. But in the fall of 2021, we picked up where we left off in 2020. With all hands-on deck, we accomplished what some believed was not possible.

The Southside Community Center has served Elmira youth for over 47 years. Daily, an average of 40 children receive tutoring, meals, and socialization in the after-school program. Understandably, with the focus and limited resources applied to meeting these needs, the funding was not available for building upkeep. When Notre Dame students became aware of the need for renovations, the enthusiasm was infectious. "We can do this" became our mantra.

And we did. With 200 students, 5 days, 32 gallons of paint, 42 sheet pizzas and a shared vision, a transformation was realized. A gym floor with a pitted and dulled finish is now shiny smooth and lined for basketball. The gym walls are no longer dull grey; they are bright and colorful. An unusable room located off the gym is now a reading room, with a new carpet, chairs, and a bookshelf. Another space is now a gaming room, with LED lighting and gaming chairs. The material that was stored in this room has been relocated to the new storage shed provided and assembled by our students. The entry stairwell has fresh paint and new treads. Additional paint and decorating contributed to a face-lift for the upstairs space. The wooden handicapped entry ramp was scrapped and painted. Much landscaping was completed with the removal and trimming of trees and scrubs. Needless to say, the Southside Community Center renovation was a tremendous accomplishment and success.

Our students were delighted to gather at an assembly where a live feed from the Community Center captured the children's reactions upon viewing their updated space. Their joy complimented ours. The opportunity to have an immediate and direct impact is a blessing with a lasting impression. We know that Catherine McAuley smiles upon these acts of mercy and kindness, and we are proud to continue her legacy of caring for those in need through our annual Mercy Movement projects.





# Golden Mass

If you were to ask Notre Dame students what they love most about the holiday season, Golden Mass would be at the top of their list. The long-standing Notre Dame tradition of accepting referrals of families from the Elmira City School District and providing for their Christmas is an undertaking and mission that deeply impacts our students. 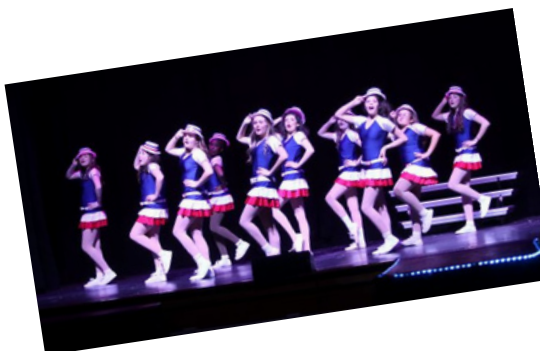

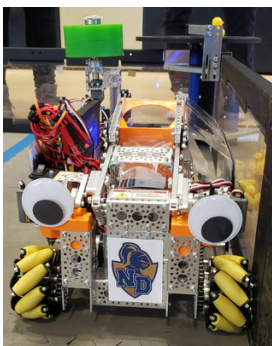


# Robotics Department

The 2021-22 FRC robotics season yielded a cohesive team, one that valued everyone's talents and contributions which certainly was a factor in the team's success this past year. The FRC #3799 Electric Fire Robotics team was excited to return to in-person meetings and work hands-on again, while designing, building, wiring, and programming the 125# robot (aka D-Bug) for the 2022 game Rapid React! Competing at the annual Finger Lakes Regional Competition at Rochester Institute of Technology in March 2022, brought with it a myriad of emotions. It was the very same spot three years ago, when the team's season was brought to an abrupt halt in 2020 due to the pandemic. This year, #3799 Electric Fire's robot, led by our skillful Drive Team, supported by our responsive Pit Crew, and strategically guided by our well-informed Scouting Team, managed to take our team all the way to the finals! This in conjunction with our exceptional Chairman's team who created and delivered a strong presentation about the community impact that our team has had in promoting STEM in our local community gave us much of which to be proud. The team was thrilled to be a 2022 Finger Lakes Regional finalist.

Notre Dame's middle school FTC #16854 Nuclear Detonation Robotics team had another great year in 2021. The team consisted of four returning 8th graders and welcomed eight new 7th graders to the team. The season started slowly since there is always a lot to teach and learn with new team members. Our robot drivetrain was working by the first tournament but unfortunately the lift was not. However, the competition was a learning experience. By the second tournament, a month later, the team had a fully functioning robot with lift and autonomous programs. Nuclear Detonation placed 6th at this tournament, a great accomplishment given that the Notre Dame team is comprised of only 7th & 8th grade students competing against teams that have members in grades 7-12.

A large portion of the FRC & FTC robotics teams' success was due to the positive energy of the teams, the guidance and dedication of the mentors, and the generosity of our loyal sponsors who are willing to help fund this life-changing program. This past June our FRC team graduated eight seniors with five of them planning to continue their education and training in a STEM-related field. We were pleased to have one graduating senior accepted into Corning Incorporated's Technical Pipeline Program.

# Opportunities for Giving

## Gifts of Cash

This gift is usually made by credit card or check payable to Notre Dame High School and is tax-deductible to the extent permitted by law. Donors may find that they are able to increase the size of their gift by extending payments on a monthly or quarterly basis until the end of the school's fiscal year.

## Honor and Memorial Gifts

Gifts may be given in honor or in memory of a specific individual or loved one. When a commemorative gift is received, the Office of Advancement notifies the honoree or the family of the deceased.

## Gifts of Appreciated Securities

Publicly traded stocks or mutual funds that have appreciated in value and have been held for more than twelve months offer two advantages. First, the donor pays no capital gains tax on the appreciation in accordance with the tax law changes in 1997. Second, the full current market value qualifies as a charitable contribution deduction.

## Matching Gifts

Matching gift programs boost your contribution and provide strong dollar support by doubling, or even tripling, donations. Corporate matching gifts offer an exceptional opportunity for you to substantially increase your gift to our campaigns and help us to reach our goals.

## Planned Giving

In the life of schools, Notre Dame is still young but it is important to plan for its future. One of the best ways for you to help us ensure Notre Dame's longevity and map its future is through Planned Giving.

A planned gift is any major gift made in a lifetime or at death as a part of a donor's overall financial and/or estate plan. Planned giving often allows individuals to make larger gifts than they could make from their annual income. By making a planned gift to Notre Dame you can make a difference.

These planned gifts include gifts by will, gifts that pay income, gifts that protect your assets, gifts from retirement plans, gifts of life insurance, gifts by estate note. Gifts by will are a type of bequest that may be for a specific sum, or for a specific percentage of an estate, the residue of an estate, or on a contingent basis. The estate will receive a charitable deduction for the value of the gift transferred to Notre Dame High School.

Unrestricted donations are the most useful type of gift. This allows the funds to be allocated by Notre Dame wherever the need is greatest. With a restricted donation, you may designate that a gift supports a special purpose.

Annual tuition accounts for approximately 60% of the full cost of educating a Notre Dame student. Much of the difference is made up through donations to the Annual Fund.
